



Safe environment

Safety is critical for us at the university. In this leaflet, you will find important information and procedures on how to respond during various security incidents.

1. **Be aware of your surroundings** and let them know if something seems dangerous.
 - a. It could be a suspicious object or person.
 - b. Always contact anyone on the school staff you trust.
You can also contact the CU Safety Management helpline at **+420 771 275 564**.
 - c. If there is a physical incident or severe other danger, call the police directly on 158.
2. **Do not bring weapons** or other means of self-defense into the building. If you feel unsafe, please get in touch with the CU Safety Management team on **+420 771 275 564**.

3. **In the event of a severe physical incident** (including a shooting):
 - a. If you can, **RUN!**
 - b. If you can't escape, **HIDE!**
 - c. If you can't hide, **FIGHT!**

When you're safe, call 158.

4. **If you find an object that you suspect is an IED** (improvised explosive device):
 - a. Do not touch or open the object.
 - b. Move to a safe distance.
If you can see the object, you are not safe.
 - c. Please inform the police at 158 and the CU Safety Management at **+420 771 275 564**.
 - d. If possible, encourage others around you avoid the object.

5. **If you feel anxious at school or need psychological counselling**, do not hesitate to contact one of the crisis and intervention psychological helplines.
